


The rise of language learning apps

- More learners have turned to apps to learn a language.
- Language learning apps were downloaded 231 million times in 2023.

Language Learning App Downloads

Language learning apps were downloaded 231 million times in 2023, an improvement on 2022 but still below 2020 levels.

What is Mobile Learning or MALL?

 Learning a second or foreign language through the use of one or more of various mobile devices (Stockwell, 2022)



Potential of MALL (Reinders & Pegrum, 2022)

mobility of the devices, learners, and learning experience

Other benefits

- flexible, customized, self-paced
- improving students' engagement through gamification and other design elements
- promoting learner autonomy through self-regulated learning strategies



Is mobile learning effective?

- Burston & Giannakou's (2022) meta-analysis
 - 3,500 MALL-related studies, overviews, and meta-analyses since the early 1990s
 - Positive impacts when comparing mobile vs. non-mobile learners and improvements between pre- and post-tests
 - But most studies focuses on vocabulary (34%), reading (20%), and grammar (12%)



What the research shows


- 3-months of study on Babbel with an average of 11.61 hours → 0.7 of an ACTFL level in speaking (Loewen et al., 2020)
- 26.8 hours on Duolingo in three months → one ACTFL sublevel in oral proficiency from Novice High to Intermediate Low (Smith et al., 2024)
- The number of sessions predicted better learning outcomes (Smith et al., 2024)
- At the lower level, app-based learning seems to be as effective as classroom-learning and requires less time. It can be because it relies on short episodes that occur more regularly


- Mobile learning is effective because of its convenience and regular practice
